2.	Ministry of Interior	In present, Department of Local Administration, Ministry of Interior in collaboration with National Health Security Office (NHSO) are drafting law related to establish Local Administration's employees' Fund as well as being amending essential relevant regulations.

Office of Civil Service Commission and Ministry of labor	Agree with the recommendations related to the amendment of National Health Security Act B.E. 2545 (2002), article 9 and 10 explaining that if any health-service recipients are entitles to be treated under other Schemes, they need to exercise their right from such Schemes. If the right they received is less than those under the National Health Security Scheme, NHSO will be responsible for the different expenditure. In addition, Ministry of Labor agrees with the recommendation related to the enactment of Protecting Injured Persons from Medical Services Bill and Social Security Bill
4.	Bureau of the Budget	Agree with the NHRCT's recommendations and the relevant authorities should appropriately consider these recommendations according to their responsibility.
